Class Descriptions

Young 3's 8:30 am – 11:30 am 9:00 – 3:00 pm This class is for children who will be turning three years old between July 1st and February 1st.

Children must be potty trained. As this will be the first preschool experience for most children, there will be an emphasis on social emotional development. Developmentally appropriate concepts using the Arizona Early Learning Standards will be introduced in a play-based environment.

Preschool (Mixed-Age) 8:30 am – 11:30 am

This class is for children 3 or 4 years old by September 1. Children will be working on development in social/ emotional, physical and cognitive areas using the Arizona Early Learning Standards. The developmental needs of all learners will be met in a play-based environment, including children preparing for Kindergarten.

Preschool (Mixed-Age) 9:00 am – 3:00 pm & 8:30 am – 2:30 pm

These classes are for children 3 or 4 years old by September 1. Children will be working on development in social/ emotional, physical and cognitive areas using the Arizona Early Learning Standards in a play-based environment.

Spanish Immersion 9:00 am – 3:00 pm & 8:30 am – 2:30 pm

Spanish Immersion has a focus on Spanish Language development and is appropriate for children who are both experienced and inexperienced with Spanish, and proficient in the English language as developmentally appropriate for their age.

Chinese/Mandarin Immersion 9:00 am – 3:00 pm

Chinese/Mandarin Immersion has a focus on Chinese/Mandarin Language development and is appropriate for children who are experienced and inexperienced with the Mandarin language. Children should be proficient in the English language as developmentally appropriate for their age.

All children in full day classes (6 hours) must bring their own lunch every day.

Nap Time 12:30 – 2:30

We are required to offer a naptime when children are in school longer than 5 hours. Parents will select a nap or no nap option at the time of registration. We understand that children's needs change and communication about naps will remain open.

Lunch Bunch

This class runs from 11:30 am – 1:30 pm each afternoon and can be added to any ½ day class. During Lunch Bunch, the teaching staff plan activities connected to AZ Early Learning Standards to enrich what is being taught in the mornings. Children have some time outside to play after they eat and then come inside for circle time and inside choices.

Extended AM/PM Sessions

Each family has the opportunity to extend their day beyond the core classes. We are open from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm. Please register for extended sessions if you need additional time. During extended care, staff-to-child ratios are maintained in a developmentally appropriate environment. In order to staff accordingly, it is important that you register for any time needed. We are not always able to accommodate last minute changes.
